

IF YOU USE THE FOOTPATHS ON RUDGE HILL FARM

A PROPOSAL HAS BEEN MADE TO BUILD A SYNTHETIC FUEL PLANT OVER
ALMOST 70 ACRES OF THE LAND ON RUDGE HILL FARM

THE PLANT WILL BE UP TO 25 “CLUSTERS” , EACH CONSISTING OF 2 X 40
foot CONTAINERS WITH A 13 metre GAS BALLOON AND A 40,000 litre
WATER TANK, AND ANOTHER SOLAR FARM TO POWER IT. IN ADDITION IT
WILL REQUIRE A LARGE NUMBER OF ACCESS ROADS AND SECURITY
FENCING.

WHAT IS VERY CLEAR IS THAT IT WILL RUIN THIS AREA.
DEVELOPMENTS OF THIS KIND SHOULD BE BUILT ON INDUSTRIAL SITES
NOT ON AGRICULTURAL FIELDS.
